The Abstract should contain a maximum of 300 words written in A4 Word document, the font –Times New Roman 12, normal margins – 2.5 cm, the line spacing 1.15 and up to 5 keywords. The Abstracts accepted by the Program Committee will be printed in the Book of Abstracts. Full papers can be submitted through the Symposium Organizer to the Soil and Plant journal (published by the Serbian Soil Science Society, Belgrade, the M52 category).

The date and venue of the Symposium

The symposium will be held in Vršac, Hotel Serbia, September 09. - 11, 2020.

Presentation type

Abstracts may be submitted for oral or poster presentations. The Review Committee will decide whether the paper should be presented in Oral Presentation or Poster Sessions. The authors will be informed of the acceptance of the papers and the way of presenting by June 10. 2020.

Symposium registration

The registration fee for the event is 6000 RSD (50 euro) for payments made until September the 1st. The registration fee after the deadline and on the day of the beginning of the symposium will be 8000RSD (65 EUR). The registration fee for students and PhD students is 3000.00 RSD (25 EUR).
